## Tree & Shrub Catalog

Welcome to our 2024 tree and shrub catalog! This catalog includes descriptions of our cowboy tough, Wyoming-ready trees and shrubs we have in stock at our nursery. Plants marked with a Y after Dubois indicate the plant will do well in the high country of Fremont County nearer to elevations of 8,000 Feet. **The highlighted descriptions indicate a new addition to our catalog.** Our list is fairly extensive; however, if we do not stock a plant you are interested in, please ask us, if it seems that the plant should thrive in your area, we will do our best to obtain it for you.

Sweetwater Garden sells two types of nursery stock: container and ball and burlap (B&B).

Our container stock is purchased from reputable growers, or it is stock that we have potted, grown, and over-wintered at the nursery. We over-winter several hundred pots in blocks outside, so our potted stock is acclimated to the onset of spring in Fremont County. Our selection includes hundreds of varieties of trees and shrubs in different sizes.

The largest of our trees are ball and burlap, meaning that the roots are contained in a large ball of soil that is covered with burlap. Some of these trees have been over-wintered at the nursery. Others come from Idaho and Colorado tree farms that we have done business with for several years. These premier nurseries produce the best trees available and grown for our region. We only sell trees that have been properly root-pruned, fertilized, branch pruned, and grown in weed-free soil.

### A Note About Hardiness

All of the plants on this list have been found to thrive in our area. The USDA Zones that we have cited are listed for your convenience. The zones are an indication of cold tolerance – the lower the zone, the more cold-tolerant the plant. However, we have found that soil type, water quality, micro-climate, and elevation are as important as cold tolerance when evaluating whether or not a plant will survive at a given site. If you have questions about whether or not a plant will thrive in your area, please reach out to us.
