PLUMS

Pollination with plums can be tricky. Unlike apples, simply growing two different varieties that flower at the same time does not ensure fruit production. As a rule of thumb, Toka will work best but check our chart to make sure you have a compatible match.

Black Tartarian requires Bing or Stella. Bing requires Black Tartarian or Stella.

All others are self-fruitful and will produce fruit by themselves.
